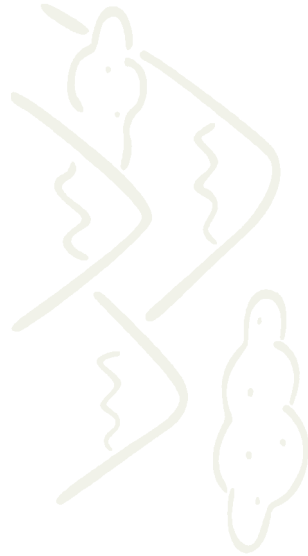


MEDIATION: MORE VALUE FOR THE COST
